Before the show starts, you might need to go to the Box Office to get your tickets.


You might need to wait in a line.

When it is time for the show, you will go through these doors.




Then you will show your tickets to the friendly helpers at the door who will give directions.

What other animals can you see?




When the show starts, it will be time to be quiet and listen. The lights will turn down a little bit – but it will not go too dark.


The performers will begin to tell you a story.

They will use words, acting, and lots of puppets!




